Notes to Schedule of Expenditures of Federal Awards Year Ended June 30, 2013

Note 1. Basis of Presentation

The accompanying Schedule of Expenditures of Federal Awards (the Schedule) includes the federal grant activity of San Diego State University Research Foundation (the Foundation) under programs of the federal government for the year ended June 30, 2013, and is presented on the accrual basis of accounting. The information in the Schedule is presented in accordance with the requirements of Office of Management and Budget (OMB) Circular A-133, *Audits of States, Local Governments, and Non-Profit Organizations.* Because the Schedule presents only a selected portion of the operations of the Foundation, it is not intended to, and does not, present the financial position, changes in net position or cash flows of the Foundation.

Note 2. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

Expenditures reported on the Schedule are reported on the accrual basis of accounting. Such expenditures are recognized following the cost principles obtained in OMB Circular A-122, Cost Principles for Non-Profit Organizations, wherein certain types of expenditures are not allowable or are limited as to reimbursement. Negative amounts shown on the Schedule represent adjustments or credits made in the normal course of business to amounts reported as expenditures in prior years. Pass-through entity identifying numbers are presented where available.

Note 3. Contingencies

As a result of inquiries from an outside funding source, the Foundation conducted an in-depth review of specific grant funds to ensure costs were appropriately charged. As a result of the internal review, the Foundation has accrued approximately \$231,000 and has paid approximately \$369,000 as of June 30, 2013. Management believes that the final outcome of these proceedings will not have a material adverse effect on the Foundation's Schedule of Expenditures of Federal Awards.

Internal Control Over Financial Reporting

In planning and performing our audit of the financial statements, we considered the Foundation's internal control over financial reporting (internal control) to determine the audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances for the purpose of expressing our opinion on the financial statements, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the Foundation's internal control. Accordingly, we do not express an opinion on the effectiveness of the Foundation's internal control.
